



## APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

NOTE: Co-op membership is based on the principle of 'one member, one vote'. Membership is individual. All family members 18 or older wishing to live in the co-op must complete a separate application, and submit their \$50 membership fee.

### ELIGIBILITY

- I am 18 years of age or over.
- I am in agreement with the general principles of the co-operative movement and those which apply specifically to the Old Grace Not-for-Profit Housing Co-op Ltd. I have noted and support the principle of consensus decision-making, and the expectation that members participate as fully as possible in the decision-making and other volunteer work required for the co-op to remain viable.
- I understand that in addition to my membership fee, a further financial commitment (for example, purchase of shares in the co-op) will be required, if and as housing units become available to me. I further understand that both sums are refundable in full if I do not wish to continue membership in the co-op.
- I understand that becoming a member of the co-op at this point does not automatically guarantee me a housing unit in the new co-op. A separate decision making-process will be put into place to allocate units.
- I hereby apply for membership and submit my fee of \$50.00 made payable to the Old Grace Housing Co-operative, c/o the address at the end of this form.
